### **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:**

The David T. Chase Institute was established in 1986 “to serve the university, the community, and the entire state,”<sup>1</sup>. “With the support of David T. and Rhonda Chase, the Institute is dedicated to supporting the advancement of the free enterprise system. The principle underlying the Institute’s mission is that capitalism can provide profitable business growth in a positive social environment. In American business and industry, there are many opportunities for small businesses to grow, create jobs, and reward their owner-operator. The institute promotes this concept by offering educational programs and activities about the free market enterprise.”<sup>2</sup>

This collection offers general correspondence, brochures and program information from the Chase Institute Lecture Series, early Board of Directors minutes (1988-1989), annual reports, booklets from the Monograph Series, plus photographs and video recordings of its guest speakers.

### **SERIES DESCRIPTION:**

#### Series I – Correspondence

This series includes correspondence between the David Chase Institute and Eastern Connecticut State University faculty and staff regarding upcoming programs dating from 1988-2011.

#### Series II – Events

This series includes invitations and programs from the Lecture Series and Chase Medallion Conferment events held on the Eastern Connecticut State University campus. Video recordings of events from 2000-2011 are filed together in Series VI.

#### Series III – Publications

This series includes event flyers, lecture booklets from the Monograph Series and other materials which promote the David Chase Institute and its programs.

#### Series IV – Minutes & Reports

This series contains minutes from the David Chase Institute Board of Directors meetings from 1988 and 1989. It also offers a small selection of annual reports dating from 1991-1993.

#### Series V – Photographs

This series contains photographs of events including an early group photo of participants in the Junior Chase Fellows Program in 1995 and guest speakers including: Aaron Feuerstein, CEO Malden Mills (2003); Robert P. Stiller, CEO Green Mountain Coffee (2004) and Colleen C. Barrett, President Southwest Airlines (2008).

This series contains video recordings of guest speakers sponsored by the institute dating from 2000-2011.
