BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

Name	John J. DelMonte, 1951-1991
Title	John J. DelMonte Collection, 1968-1991
Extent	30 linear feet.
Arrangement	This collection was divided into five series: memorabilia, playbills, theatre miscellany, vinyl recordings and compact disc recordings. Memorabilia was organized and filed in chronological order. The playbills were sorted and filed alphabetically by theatre, then by play title. Vinyl recordings were sorted as classical or popular music and organized alphabetically by composer (classical) or artist-musician-playwright (popular). Compact discs were sorted and filed alphabetically by composer.
Provenance	The John J. DelMonte material, including books, playbills, vinyl and compact disc recordings were donated to the university by Madeline Bernstein, the mother of former student, John J. DelMonte in 1993. In September 2001, the non-print portion of the collection was moved to the Smith Library Archives and Special Collections, room 471, "John J. DelMonte Listening Room". In December 2011 Ms. Bernstein added audio and videocassettes to the collection.

BIOGRAPHY:

John J. DelMonte Jr. (1951-1991) of Waterford, Connecticut graduated from Eastern in 1973. "While at Eastern, John DelMonte acted, wrote, directed and served as president of the Drama Society. He helped in the creation of the Harry Hope Theatre. He organized an annual student drama contest and wrote."¹ Following graduation he had an active and multi-faceted career with the Metropolitan Opera and Lincoln Center in New York City and with the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center and Ivoryton Playhouse in Connecticut. "John was an artist and as such a dreamer but unlike many dreamers he made his dream come true even for a short moment..." (memorial reading)² John DelMonte's mother, Madeline Bernstein, generously donated his collections to the university in 1993. A dedication program was held on May 6, 1993. Later the collection was moved to a permanent home: the John J. DelMonte Listening Room in the J. Eugene Smith Library Archives and Special Collections which was celebrated with a dedication program held on September 27, 2000.³

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The collection includes approximately 500 playbills from New York City Broadway and Off Broadway shows as well as many other New England theatres. The collection also offers related information taken from his time as a student at Eastern, as well as material from theatre workshops and special programs he attended. The vinyl recordings (approximately 300) include such composers as Haydn, Mozart & Puccini and renown performers such as Maria Callas & Renata Scotto in the classical collection. The popular recordings include music from many popular Broadway Musicals as well as the music of popular singers of the 1950s, 1960s and early 1970s. The CD collection includes such composers as Bellini, Verdi and Tchaikovsky. Audiocassette and video recordings include works by Meyerbeer, Donizetti, Puccini and Verdi and performances by Renata Scotto and the Metropolitan Opera.

This collection is housed in the John J. DelMonte Listening Room, Room 471, of the J. Eugene Smith Library located in the Connecticut Studies/Archives & Special Collections area.

SERIES DESCRIPTION:

Series I –Memorabilia

This series includes correspondence, articles and news clippings that describe John DelMonte's involvement with the drama society. It includes original listing of items donated to Eastern and later the Smith Library and copies of programs and photographs from the John J. DelMonte Music Collection Dedication in 1993 and the John J. DelMonte Listening Room Dedication in 2000.

Series II - Playbills

This series offers over 400 theatre playbills from more than a dozen theatres both in New York and Southern New England. The playbills are stored in numbered hanging files sorted alphabetically by theatre.

Series III – Theatre Miscellany

This series offers a variety of information related to theatres including seasonal schedules, restaurant information, memorabilia and workshop materials.

Series IV – Vinyl Recordings

This collection of classical and popular recordings (over 400 pieces) is stored in a separate record cabinet where records are filed alphabetically by composer's last name (classical) or by the name of the group or primary performer (popular).

Series V – Compact Disc Recordings

These recordings are stored in a separate cabinet in Princeton files. This collection includes the works of several composers including Bellini, Donizetti, Puccini and Strauss.

Series VI – Audiocassettes

This series offers six folders offering works by Meyerbeer, Zandonai, Donzetti, Puccini and Verdi with performances by renown conductors, companies and performers.

Series VII – Videocassettes

This series offers two video productions: Puccini's *Manon Lescaut* performed by the Metropolitan Opera Company and a recital with Renata Scotto.
