This collection includes photographs taken by Larry LaFlamme of Willimantic, a former Campus Police Officer. There are twenty one full color photographs of the Eastern Connecticut State College campus, each centering on a specific building or area. The original photographs are not dated, however, based on other photographs in the archive's collection they appear to have been taken between 1969 and 1976 when the campus was undergoing its first major expansion.
